## Supplies List:

- Foam Tape
- Black Enamel Dots
- .05mm Black Tip Marker
- Black Soot Distress Ink by Tim Holtz for Ranger Ink
- Ink Applicator
- Stapler
- Staples
- Golden Rod Stickers
- 3 Embossing Folders – different patterns
- Gold Ribbon
- Black and White Ribbon
- Red and White Bakers Twine
- Scissors
- Adhesive
  - Scor Tape – 1/4<sup>th</sup> and 1/8<sup>th</sup> inches
  - Zig Glue
  - Scotch Tacky Glue
- Ruler
- Tweezers
- Paper Cutter
- Sewing Machine – please note that using a sewing machine does dull the needle AND you will need to ensure that the adhesive is totally dry BEFORE you sew pieces together.
- Golden Brown Thread

## Cutting Diagrams:

Diagrams are shown with the paper direction as it needs to be cut. Paper is patterned, so be aware BEFORE you make the cuts.

I recommend sorting the papers into their respective page numbers as you cut. A simple pile for each page or a Ziploc bag for each page is an easy way to organize so that assembly is quick.

Please review the complete pages prior to cutting so that you are familiar with the layouts.

Measurements are as follows:

- .25 – ¼ inch
- .50 = ½ inch
- .75 = ¾ inch
- 1.00 = 1 inch

## 1A & 1B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces & sew any edges BEFORE adhering them together.
- Use a small tip marker to create stitching on the heart embellishments by simply “ticking” lines to make them appear sewn.
- Pop up the “love you” embellishment with foam tape.
- Place black enamel dots in three’s randomly AFTER you have added your photos.
- Add black enamel dots to each side of the “love you” embellishment to make it appear like it secures it in place.



## 2A & 2B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces prior to assembly.
- Staple twine onto center portion BEFORE adhering to your page.
- Use Foam Tape to pop up the 4x4 Cut Apart Title.
- Adhere heavy findings with Scotch Tacky Glue.
- Use Stickles in groups of three AFTER you glue down your photos; stickles were also added to the embellishments.
- The tag is placed with adhesive and does not retreat down into the envelope. If you would like yours to “move”, be sure to create a space in your page protector that lines up with your tag.
- Gold Ribbon is adhered with 1/8 inch Scor Tape



## 3A & 3B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces prior to assembly.
- Scallop the edges of the papers using a scallop punch or scallop cutter.
- Using a sewing machine, sew around the edges of the cardstock using a scallop setting. Adhere the cardstock before sewing being sure glue is dry prior to sewing. Place Embellishments on, after sewing is completed.
- Use Scotch Tacky Glue to adhere heavy findings.
- Use Foam Tape to pop up titles.





## 4A & 4B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces prior to assembly.
- Use Scor Tape to place ribbon on the page; then staple after completely assembled.
- The pink/red/white thin strip of paper was from a box wrap from the swap.
- Foam Tape was used to pop up titles
- Scotch Tacky glue was used to secure arrow



## 5A & 5B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces prior to assembly.
- The Title, Journaling box and embellishments were a card that was given at the swap; I simply cut it in half and used it on the pages.
- The red heart border was also a swap item. I received two red borders and cut them down the middle to create four borders. So that they could mirror each other on each page.
- Hearts are popped up with Foam Tape



## 6A & 6B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces prior to assembly.
- The hearts were given as a swap items; however I did run them through my vagabond using embossing folders to give them some texture. I choose 3 different embossing folders (one for each color) then assembled them with Zig Glue and ran my sewing machine down the middle of them with a straight stitch. Make sure the glue is fully dry BEFORE using your sewing machine!
- Hearts were adhered with Scotch Tacky Glue after all my sewing was completed.
- Stitch around the pages prior to assembly.



## 7A & 7B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces prior to assembly.
- I would do this page LAST! Yes I know it says page 7; however any left over embellishments can be used here!
- I created the first layer by simply gluing them directly to the base pages, leaving a finger space between each one; then make the second layer by popping them in between the first layer with foam tape. This is a great way to use up all those cute embellies!!



## 8A & 8B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces prior to assembly.
- I used the border pages and did not have to cut each strip apart; I did cut out the black and white check so that it did not compete with my background pages.
- Distress the borders by using a stylus to score each border and distress between each one; or cut them all apart for more versatility. The choice is yours!



## 9A & 9B - Be My Valentine

### Sherri's Tips & Tricks

- Distress pieces prior to assembly.
- Wrap bakers twine around the photo mats prior to adhering them with Foam Tape.
- Pop up title with Foam Tape.
- Page 9B – Adhere the “lips piece” first, making sure the top is even with the hearts piece from 9A. Then adhere the red hearts that runs across the bottom of 9B, making sure it is even with the bottom the hearts piece from 9A. The fill in the remaining pieces so that your scallops show.
